- A normal school career
- Average family situation
- Everything seems to be all right



- Suddenly Rosaly stays away from school



Stages of the reaction on unauthorized absence

Stage 1

- Registration
- Identify
- Talk to the parents about their responsibilities



Stage 2

- First warning
- Second warning
- Refer to youth care
- Voluntary Intervention of youth care



Stage 3

- Compulsory Intervention of the Child Protection Council
- Sanctions



Stage 4

- Rehabilitation by the Drop-Out safety net provision



Stage 5

- Return to vocational training and/or work
